January 21, 2009 @ Metea Park Nature Center

On February 17-20 there will be a CIG training for naturalists, and a regional meeting for NAI will also be held at Metea in February.

Fox Island

Kate reported that the Indiana Master Naturalist class is full, and will begin in March and run into May. This is the 5th year for this excellent program. The Alliance approved money for new Display boxes. The Alliance will soon meet with members of the Fort Wayne Astronomical Society regarding their ongoing project.

Jeff is still looking into the possibility of implementing credit/debit card sales at county park nature centers.
