Welcome to Allen County Parks *RACE* into the WILD camp!

Fox Island's *RACE into the WILD* Spring Day Camp is open for registration! Camp runs April 5-9th, 2010, Monday-Friday, 9:00-5:00pm. Camp is for ages 6-12. **Counselor's in Training, ages 13 and up**, may volunteer their time.

The Camp Directors are Natalie Haley and Ron Zartman. Inside this packet you will find valuable information that will help with reservations.

Campers will experience a week filled with scavenger hunts, survival skill tests and great adventures in the outdoors. They will bring home a self-made survival kit by the end of the week! Building shelters, fire, and finding water will be just some of the challenges presented to our campers this year.

Pre-registration cut-off date is March 26, 2010. Minimum registration of 10 campers is required in order to run this camp. Maximum registration of 30 campers will be accepted. All programs are subject to cancellation.

Homesickness

Our staff will help children through homesickness so that they have a rewarding experience. We will work with the camper and encourage them to stay for the day. If a camper becomes homesick, parents will be called by the camp directors in order to work out the best possible solution for the camper.

Registration

Registration deadline is March 26th, 2010.

Complete all questions on the registration form. If you are registering for more than one camper, please copy an individual registration form for each camper. Registrations are accepted in the order in which they are received. Full payment is required for us to reserve your spot. If a program is full (maximum of 30 campers per session), a waiting list will be created. A confirmation brochure will be sent to you after your camper's registration payment is received. Payments/Deposits

Camp Cost: \$100.00 for the week per child. Sack lunches *from home* are required daily. We will provide drinks and snacks. Go green and bring a reusable, labeled, water bottle. The early-bird rate (for registrations prior to March 14th, 2010) is \$95.00 per camper. Golden Parks Pass holder's registration fee is \$90.00 per camper. Checks payable to: Allen County Parks and Recreation. Returned checks are subject to a \$25 return check fee. Refunds are subject to management approval.

Pre-registration is required. No walk-in registrations the first day of camp will be taken.
